Horse oil -- is oil collected from horse fat as it reads.

Oil is classified roughly into animal oil and vegetable oil. Camellia oil in vegetable oil and horse oil in animal oil have structures close to human skin. Skin troubles such as spots, wrinkles, and dry skin may cause skin aging, mainly due to lack of skin moisture. However, even if moisture is given temporarily by lotion etc., the effect does not last due to natural evaporation. In order to keep the skin moisturized, it is important to keep it hydrated as well as retain the moisture within the skin.

As oil, horse oil prevents moisture from diverging from the skin surface. It is also highly regarded to have excellent penetrating power to human skin as it permeates moisture firmly into the skin by reaching deep into the pores.

Deer oil -- is refined oil extracted from deer fat content. It is composed of less unsaturated fatty acid and abundant saturated fatty acid that makes it good oil for shampoo and soap into the skin by reaching deep into the pores.

Deer oil has been used in China since ancient times as a common medicine and is said to be effective for burns, cuts, roughness of heels, etc.

It was also widely used as a medicine among hunters in Japan as well.

Boar oil -it is called "Botan (Peony) oil" in Japan- has a structure that is close to horse oil but has higher penetration power than the latter.

It is recommended for moisturizing cream and essence.

Emu oil -- Emu is a large bird resembling an ostrich inhabited in inland Australia. It is a very powerful ancient bird that has survived for over 80 million years in a dry desert area. It is known that there are few cases of death due to external injuries and it has become known that the main factor is that Emu birds' skin regeneration power is very strong compared to other animals. It is also known that to be able to protect their eggs, Emu birds can bear 60 days without water or food and instead consume subcutaneous fat for nutrition.
